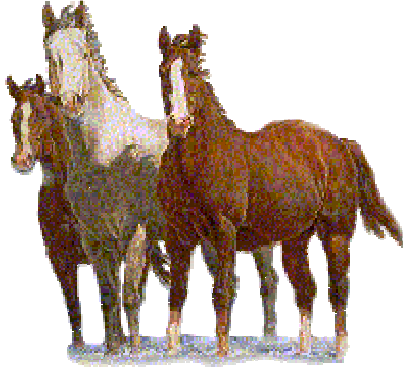

Stallion Service Contract

This agreement is made and entered into on the _____ day of _____ 2011 between _____ (mare owner) and Davrac Quarter Horses the owner of stallion **Coliban ThreeBars Of Gold Q-62376**. The mare owner is the owner of the horse known as _____ (name of mare), registration number _____, and a copy of whose registration papers are attached. The parties hereto contract for the servicing of the said mare by the said stallion for the **2011** breeding season, which ends on the **31st January 2012** subject to the following terms and conditions.

1. The parties hereto contract for the servicing of the above said mare for the fee of **\$1200** (GST inclusive). The mare owner has paid the stallion owner a non-refundable booking fee of **\$300** the receipt of which is acknowledged.
2. Agistment will be charged from the date of arrival of the mare at stud until the date of departure inclusive, at the rate of \$8.00 per day. (Agistment price is subject to current feed prices and subject to change). All mares are held in individual yards and are hard feed twice daily with hay available adlib.
3. All veterinary expenses incurred for the mare, including pregnancy tests, will be paid for by the mare owner.
4. While the mare is in the custody of the stud, the stallion owner shall not be liable for any sickness, disease, injury or death which may be suffered by the mare or it's progeny. Should the stallion owner be unable or fail to perform this contract by reason of death or injury to the stallion, all fees paid by the mare owner will be refunded and neither party shall have any rights against the other under the provisions of paragraph 1 of this contract.
5. **LIVE FOAL GUARENTEE** for the purpose of this contract shall be defined as a foal that lives for a period of **1 week**. Stallion owner will provide a free return the following season only, if a live foal fails to result from the mating. (Subject to conditions being met in paragraph 9). The above is subject to the condition that notification must be made to the stallion owner within 48hrs after time of foaling or aborting, that mare did not produce a live foal. A certified veterinarian statement must be received within 14 days of said mares foaling or aborting, giving particulars to substantiate live foal guarantee or live foal guarantee becomes null and void. Upon rebreeding all vet and agistment fees are payable again.
6. The mare owner agrees to only book a mare that is **HALTER BROKE AND GENTLE**.
7. All transport arrangements and costs shall be the responsibility of the mare owner. The mare owner must give at least 48 hours notice to the stud of their intention to deliver or collect mare.
8. This contract shall not be assigned or transferred to another party without the written consent of the stallion owner.

9. A veterinarian nominated by the stallion owner will carry out all pregnancy tests on mares at stud. Owners who wish to have an early pregnancy scan performed at 16 days, prior to removal of mare from stud, **must undertake a follow up 42 day test to satisfy Stud LFG requirements.** For all mares staying at stud for 42 day preg test, if the mare shall be found to not be pregnant then no service fee shall be payable but all other monies herein mentioned shall be paid and this agreement shall in all other respects be performed and observed. The above applies to mares that have not settled by the end of the breeding season. Mare owners who wish to remove the mare from stud prior to the 42 day test must have accounts paid in full. The veterinarian's original certificate of pregnancy shall be the property of the mare owner.
10. Application for registration certificates/service certificates will only be issued at the time that all accounts have been settled in full and a **positive 42 day pregnancy test is on file at stud.**
11. **Artificial Insemination (A.I)** is available to the mare owner. The mare owner shall pay all associated insemination costs. Collection and transport costs of the shipment of semen from the stud to the nominated veterinary clinic will be the responsibility of the mare owner who will be billed directly from the stud's veterinarian. **The sum of \$1200 must be paid to the stud prior to delivery of any semen.**
12. Upon arrival at stud, all mares will be drenched prior to breeding. These costs will be the responsibility of the mare owner and will be invoiced accordingly.
13. The preferred methods of payments are cash, cheque or electronic funds transfer (EFT).
Please note all cheques are to be made out to Davrac Quarter Horses.
